Title: Quadbar PhD Scholarship in Engineering Solutions to Farm Safety

Location: Toowoomba/Springfield/Ipswich/Online

Details of Scholarship:

The establishing donor, Quadbar, has supported an endowed scholarship to assist students undertaking PhD studies in the field of agricultural engineering.

This scholarship is open to students commencing or continuing the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) with the wider goal of growing diverse and innovative engineering solutions to farm safety.

Value:

- Stipend of AUD \$36,000 per year
- Maximum period of tenure of an award is 3 years. Periods of study already undertaken towards the degree will be deducted from the period of tenure.

Eligibility:

To be eligible applicants must:

- have met the entry requirement criteria for the <u>Doctor of Philosophy (DPHD)</u>;
- have applied for, or currently enrolled in a PhD at UniSQ;
- not be receiving equivalent support providing a benefit greater than 75% of the student's stipend rate;
- be eligible to commence or continue their study in 2025.

Selection Criteria:

Applicants will be ranked on the basis of:

- Academic achievement and the potential for scholastic success;
- Quality of the research proposal;
- Demonstrated expertise in engineering solutions;
- Demonstrated interest in farm safety.

How to apply:

To apply, please ensure you have digital copies of the below information:

- Cover letter addressing criteria of engineering solutions and farm safety;
- Curriculum vitae; encompassing any research presentations and/or publications;
- <u>Preliminary Research Thesis Topic Proposal (DOTX 153KB)</u>, to be completed with the proposed supervisory team;
- Education qualifications (testamur and academic transcripts for all undergraduate and postgraduate awards;
- Documentation confirming citizenship.

Applicants must have their current/prospective supervisor complete the <u>Supervisor support letter.</u>

Application must be made via the **<u>UniSQ Scholarship Application Management System</u>** by the closing date.
